Honeywell-Garrett Retirees Club Board Meeting Minutes April 6, 2022

President Dolf Strom called the Honeywell-Garrett Retirees Club (HGRC) Board meeting to order at 11:00 AM. Those in attendance were: Diane Bennett, Jim Brink, John Cunningham, Bob Davenport, Frank Holman, Ken Krieger, Diane Rosenberger, Mark Steele, Dolf Strom and Brian Unsworth. The meeting was held at the Gecko Grill, 7707 E. McDowell Rd., Scottsdale.

Jim Brink gave the Treasurer's report. The Club balance is \$5979.99. Contributions by the Club to the Scholarship Fund were discussed. Mark moved to contribute \$1500.00 to the Scholarship Fund. John seconded and the motion passed.

Some proposed changes to the Club Operating Guidelines were discussed. Dolf suggested a revision to the proposed revised Guidelines. He suggested that sections 6.3 and 6.7 be combined to one function. After discussion it was decided to leave the proposed Guidelines unchanged. John moved to approved the revised Guidelines and recommend to the membership that they be approved. Frank seconded and the motion passed. Dolf will send an email announcing the changes to the membership and post the revised Guidelines with changes highlighted to the website. Mark will bring paper copies to the next Club meeting.

The Spring picnic was discussed. 45 sign-ups are needed and so far only 14 have indicated they plan to attend. If not enough sign up by the deadline, the picnic will be cancelled.

The speaker schedule was reviewed. The April speaker will be Bob Buddecke, VP of supply chain for Honeywell Aerospace and the May speaker will be Katherine Gudgel who will speak on scams to look out for. Mike Madsen, President of Honeywell Aerospace will be the October speaker.

Frank reported that the Fix-It Guys had 3 calls last month.

The Membership Directory was discussed. It has been 3 years since it has been updated. It was agreed to print a new Directory and distribute it at the Monthly Club meeting. It will be mailed to out of state members who request one.

Club charities were discussed. Mark moved to contribute \$100.00 to each of the current 8 charities the Club supports. John seconded the motion and it passed.
